

"...God is love. ...[When] we love one another, God dwells deeply within us, and God's love becomes complete in us...."

So says one of Jesus' followers as he preaches to people who never met Jesus (1 John 4: 4, 11, in *The Message*). This kind of love is about patience, forgiveness and encouragement to be the best person you can be; do you love someone like that? Did someone who has died love you like that? Isn't that what we mean when we use the word "saint"?

We do an injustice when we think a "saint" is a special person, somehow different from the rest of us. Even St. Theresa of Calcutta, formerly called Mother Teresa, was quick to say that she wasn't anyone special....just someone who loved God and in whom God's love grew.

The Church has, traditionally, named Nov 1 All Saints' Day. It is a time for us to remember those whom we love, to bear witness to our faith that even death can't stop love from being shared. That brings light into a world in which light is badly needed.

A person who is worthy of your love must surely be a saint. Come and light a candle in honour of the person you love. Our celebration of All Saints Day celebrates love in a world which needs more love. Love is from God; how can it be wrong?
