

2021 Deloraine and Area Christmas Cheer

PRODUCE REPORT

No produce goes into the adopted hampers.

Big thank you to Deloraine School for doing Peak of the Market/Farm to School vegetable program. There were 45 donated bags this year! Each bag has 5 lb potatoes, 2 lb carrots and 3 lb onions. All Mb produce!

Unfortunately this was not a good year for carrots! Whether it was too warm at harvest or poor storage, some carrots had to be discarded because of being mushy or having black icky spots. I brought home 8 bags and salvaged half of them after sorting through the good/spoiled ones. The consequence is that we had to purchase replacements but, knowing there were adequate financial resources, it wasn't a problem.

Spoiled carrots (and parsnips) have happened to us previously and it was an exceptionally warm fall that year too.

I recommend that if we are lucky to have donated veg for 2022, the veg not be put into hamper bags when sorted at the school. I assume this would be easier for the volunteers who put the veg bags together at the school for distribution. (?) It's easier for us to store and monitor the veg in the bulk bags. It is also easier to assemble the produce bags for hampers. The 5 lb bags suits a 1/2 adult hamper but the others get varying amounts of potato/carrots. Carrots will definitely be looked at carefully next year.

All hampers got a bag of apples. Depending on the # children, some hampers received more.

Single/2person hampers got ½ box of oranges (approximately 10) and all others got at least I box, a few received 2.

Produce amounts for 2021 Cheer

POTATOES (45 bags x 5 lb DONATED) + (9 X 10LBS PURCHASED) = 315 LBS

CARROTS (*25 X 2LBS DONATED) + (18 X 2 LBS PURCHASED) + (15 X 5 LBS PURCHASED) = 161 LBS

ONIONS 45 BAGS x 3lbs DONATED/ none purchased = 135LBS

Mandarin ORANGES 24 X 5lb boxes PURCHASED = 120 LBS

APPLES (GALA) 38 X 3LB BAGS PURCHASED = 114 LBS

TOTAL VEG/FRUIT = 845 LBS.

Farm to School veg storage concerns

Bags from Farm to School...might have to purchase more bags.

The bags work well for other hamper uses. A suggestion was made to give the adopted hampers bags for their produce. It makes the boxes lighter.

Possible help students from the school Social Justice group.

Are we giving too much...potatoes.

I am willing to chair the produce committee for 2022 Cheer. It would be good to have a cochair to work with me. Possibly to learn the magical formula and process of veggie math and take over for 2023

I will share how I do the produce allotment with Referral Committee and Food Committee of Donalda and Willa

Assembling Boxes has been a Produce task; Bev Huys and the EMT crew have been wonderful to do this. Could this be a part of the chair's job description? It would involve making sure we have boxes and contacting Bev and her crew about Cheer date and making sure there adequate supplies of tape.




Waskada School
