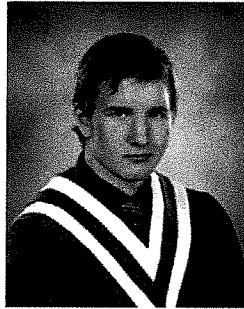
Kasey Brown - plans on entering the workforce for a year before going to university.



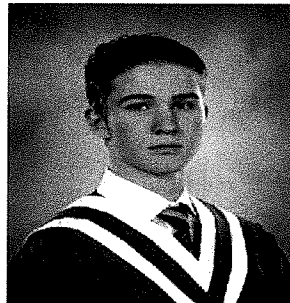
